Magnum Black

Located in Italy, this private villa is set within an expansive estate of exceptional landscape value.

The project involved a radical reconstruction, bordering on a total rebuild, including extensive topographical redefinition through major earthworks. The building rises across three levels, featuring a marked visual contrast between the front and rear elevations.

Departing from the studio's typical palette, the villa adopts a monochromatic dark exterior, heightening its architectural presence. The design extends seamlessly into the landscape, featuring terraced outdoor living areas and cascading cantilevered pools.



+Nano

+Nano is a company specializing in advanced nanotechnology treatments for surface protection. Born from an urgent brief and conceived within an exceptionally tight timeframe, the project maintains a sharp conceptual clarity.

The headquarters is designed as a multifunctional hub—integrating reception, testing areas, training zones, and operational environments—with a strong emphasis on the user experience.

At the heart of the project is the showroom area, where the surface treatment process is unveiled behind a dramatic, theatrical curtain, elevating a technical procedure into a museum-like experience. Clients are welcomed into a dedicated seating area to witness the application firsthand, under precision lighting designed to highlight the product's transformative effects.

Villa Iris

A private villa in Italy, where the triangular lot directly dictated the building's geometry.

The essential and rigorous volume unfolds as a compact form, offering a minimalist interpretation of the architectural brief.

The structure is entirely exposed, showcasing reinforced concrete, steel, and metal elements both inside and out.

The relationship between interior and exterior is emphasized by the seamless transition to the swimming pool, connected to the portico as a natural extension of the living space.

Corner glazing with non-orthogonal geometries further dissolves the boundary, integrating the house with its surroundings.





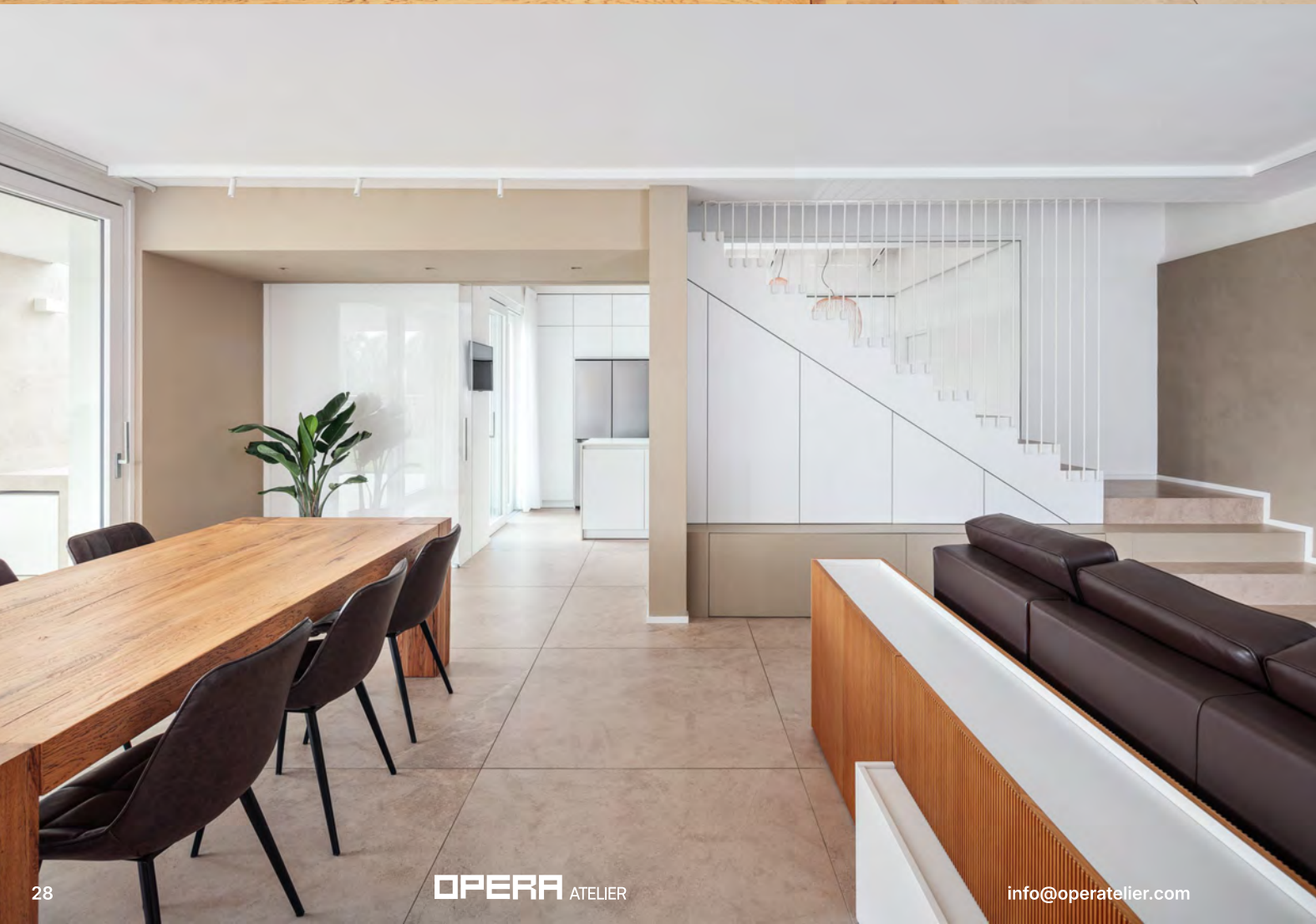
Villa Magnolia

A two-story private villa in Italy, conceived with a clear functional separation between living and sleeping quarters.

The project is defined by an expansive portico with an outdoor fireplace, created by the shifting of the upper pavilion volume over the lower level, a play of solids and voids that establishes a powerful architectural identity.

The building achieves high energy performance (Class A4) and features a photovoltaic system with integrated storage.

The construction combines load-bearing masonry with external thermal insulation and exposed timber roofing. The interiors were entirely custom-designed.



Villa Eden

Composed, horizontal architecture, where light, proportion, and framed views create a continuous dialogue with the surrounding landscape.



A private villa in Italy, developed entirely on a single level and designed to harmonize with its surroundings.

While maintaining a horizontal layout, the living area features a double-height volume that amplifies the perception of space.

A signature element is the low-set glazing, which fosters a direct, contemplative relationship with the outdoors, drawing inspiration from Japanese residential culture.

The porticos, structurally integrated with the main volume, showcase exposed white-finished metal elements, defining the project's refined architectural identity.

Damnfit

Damnfit is an exclusive one-to-one private gym, led by a prominent figure in the worlds of fitness, wellness, and longevity.

The interior design stems from the desire to create a powerful, essential, and physical environment that speaks of effort, discipline, and performance.

The workout areas are defined by dark, textural, and bold atmospheres, creating a deliberate contrast with the service areas, bathrooms and changing rooms, which are designed as softer, welcoming, and restorative spaces.

The entrance lounge sets the tone for the entire facility through refined materials such as bronzed mirrors, metallic surfaces, and ribbed stone, defining an exclusive and highly personalized experience.



Dark, tactile atmospheres built for performance, balanced by the refined softness of spaces dedicated to recovery.

Villa Net

A residential complex in Italy comprising two villas designed as a unified system, engaging in a dialogue of proportions and architectural language. The volumes develop vertically, generating expansive and airy interior spaces. A defining feature is the reinterpreted pavilion roof; by eliminating the traditional hip rafters, it creates an unusual structural and perceptual effect.



Large glazed surfaces, reaching heights of up to five meters, define the relationship between indoors and outdoors while ensuring intense natural light. The facades feature a custom-developed chromatic finish, a veiled, textural white that reacts to light, shifting toward warmer tones during the evening hours.





Casa Belvedere

Casa Belvedere is an interior design project for a private apartment, developed as a comprehensive fit-out of the living spaces. The intervention focused on the meticulous selection of finishes and the integration of both premium standard pieces and bespoke furniture, ensuring stylistic cohesion throughout the home.

Every element is tailored to the client's lifestyle, featuring handcrafted cabinetry, custom wardrobes, and a statement central table that anchors the residence's harmonious identity.

A materials-driven approach defines the interiors, creating a warm and luminous atmosphere where the raw texture of travertine meets a palette of earthy tones, subtly accentuating the architectural volumes.



I Fiordi



A residential intervention in Italy, comprising independent units developed within a single masterplan, each featuring private access and autonomous outdoor spaces.

The project strikes a balance between individuality and overall coherence, with high-performance buildings and a unified architectural language. The white surfaces, enriched by natural quartzite cladding, reflect light to create textural effects reminiscent of ice.

Particular attention was devoted to the relationship with the outdoors, with open spaces and private gardens assigned to each unit.

Il Fiore

Villa D'Arco

A private villa in Italy, designed as a synthesis between traditional architectural cues and an essential contemporary language. The project reinterprets the typical forms of the local context through clean volumes and balanced proportions. A distinctive feature is the variegated natural quartzite cladding, introducing a rich textural component that dialogues with the light-toned surfaces of the facades.

The steeply pitched roof extends from the portico toward the mezzanine area, defining a dynamic and slender profile that characterizes the building's lateral silhouette.

A dialogue between tradition and contemporary language, where tactile materials and balanced proportions define a timeless architectural identity.



Tenuta Dioniso

Tenuta Dioniso is an interior design and fit-out project for a winery in the heart of the Lugana region, housed within a sustainable, prefabricated timber structure. The intervention focuses on enhancing the architectural vision of Studio Manuel Benedikter by integrating bespoke joinery, curated lighting, and high-end finishes. Every detail is engineered to balance energy efficiency and acoustic excellence with a tailor-made aesthetic.

The project evolved through a comprehensive management process, from initial design to final setup, transforming a high-performance bio-architecture shell into a coherent, functional hospitality hub defined by understated elegance.



A holistic design approach—extending to the surrounding landscape and the creation of scenic vineyard pathways—transforms the winery into a cohesive experience where sustainable custom details and the natural environment are brought into refined balance.



Bengio

Benjo is a global leader in the production of high-performance neck protectors for go-karting, a highly technical product tailored to the individual requirements of every athlete.

The company's headquarters is a hub for top-tier motorsport professionals, including leading figures from the Formula 1 world. The interior design was born from the need to translate the spirit of racing into a physical space, while preserving the artisanal heritage and obsessive precision that define the brand.

Distinctive details, such as the fluorescent finishes on the handles inspired by the corporate logo, create an environment where speed, performance, and customization are woven into the architectural language.

Casa Sirmione



Casa Sirmione is an interior relook and procurement project, developed from an unfinished residence.

The work focused on enhancing the existing structure by integrating new bespoke joinery, metalwork, and interior architecture, designed to strengthen the property's most compelling features while personalizing the spaces to the client's needs.

The project evolved through successive layers of targeted and calibrated interventions, transforming an incomplete shell into a coherent, functional home with a powerful and unique identity.

A layered design approach transforms an unfinished space into a cohesive home, where custom details and existing elements are brought into refined balance.

Villa Mainardi

A private villa in Italy, defined by an articulated and distinctive volumetric composition. The project unfolds through two interconnected trapezoidal volumes that engage in a constant dialogue, linked by the master suite to interpret the concept of living as an evolving system.

These geometries also shape the covered outdoor spaces, creating expansive porticos finished in travertine-effect materials.

This intervention is part of a broader masterplan, currently being finalized with the completion of the landscaped areas and the swimming pool.

Two primary volumes interact in balance and tension, creating a spatial narrative of connection, separation, and continuity.





Villa Fusion

Fusion is a residential project located in a village near Lake Garda, conceived as a linear villa primarily arranged on a single ground floor level.

The design focuses on enhancing architectural identity by integrating a large pavilion roof with 15-meter white steel beams, engineered to leave the load-bearing skeleton entirely exposed while tailoring the spaces to the client's needs.

The project evolved through a focus on structural honesty, transforming a longitudinal layout into a coherent, functional home where the structure itself becomes the primary architectural expression.

This structure-driven approach transforms the living area into a double-height volume, where industrial-grade white metalwork and a large corner window are brought into a refined, harmonious balance.
